VICTORIA SPONGE – SET RECIPE

225g/8oz butter

225g/8oz caster sugar

4 medium eggs

225g/8oz self raising flour

2 tsp baking powder

Strawberry jam to fill

Caster sugar to decorate top of cake

Any items being donated to the tea tent should be provided with a full list of ingredients.
